German Example: a sort of best practice

- In Germany (§ 54 UrhG) all device and storage media used for reproductions are subject to remuneration in the law. This ensures that remuneration is paid not only for photocopiers, multifunction devices, printers, scanners and faxes, but also for PCs, tablets, mobile phones, USB sticks, hard disks or smart watches.
- In addition to the device and storage media remuneration, there is also the operator remuneration (§ 54c UrhG; "operator levy"). It obliges "large operators" of reproduction equipment (e.g. schools, universities, libraries, copy shops) to pay a reproduction fee.
- In 2018, VG WORT collected TI levies for textworks approx. € 80 million, with the additional payments for PCs for the years 2008 to 2013: € 140 million
 Principle of share: Lump sums and simplifications are permissible. The split is negotiated in between authors and publishers in CMO, not law
 (70:30 fiction / 50:50 / 100:0 audio play, screen play ...).



THE FUTURE ?

- (1) all legally permitted digital reproduction possibilities should be covered.
- (2) In the future a remuneration will have to be paid for cloud storage via a kind of new operator remuneration vis-à-vis cloud operators.
- (3) it must be ensured that an appropriate remuneration is paid for legally permitted public access (e.g. according to § 60a UrhG in the school and university sector; digital semester apparatus/digital learning apparatus).
- (4) Licensing options (Art. 17 DSM Directive) may play an important role in the future.
- (5) there are technical possibilities to pay usage-related fees to authors for copies/usage in the Internet. In the case of VG WORT, this is achieved via METIS. You may explore this with Robert Staats or on https://www.ifrro.org/sites/default/files/vg_wort_presentation_athens_jun14.pdf.
 (6) be aware: DIGITAL EUROPE is lobbying against TI Levies with the argument: streaming is not copying. The ELF-Forum may develop together strategies and wording.
